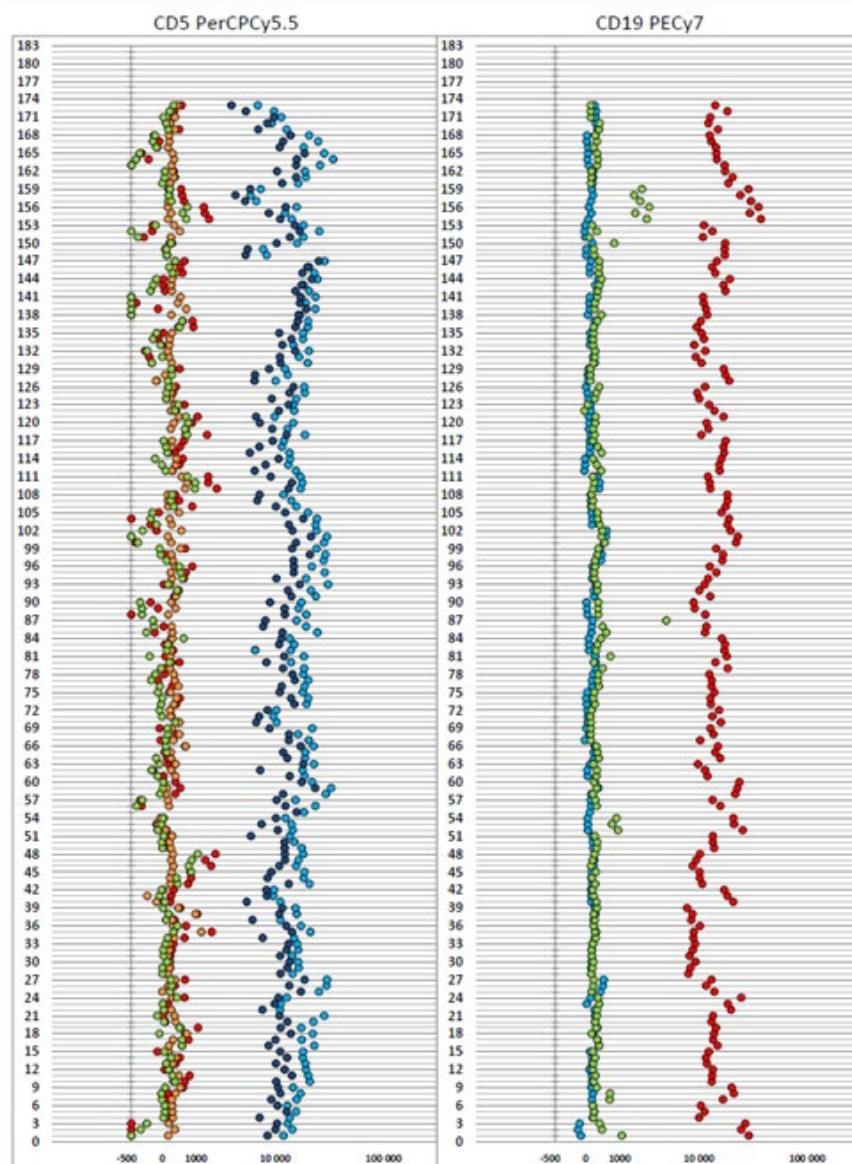


8TH EuroFlow EQA Educational Meeting
