Regina's Hope Medical Program provides two types of support opportunities for medical students in the Czech Republic to encourage global education and nurture training of future leaders in the field of medicine.

## "Regina's Hope"

The Regina's Hope(RH) program offers clinical and research training in the field of pediatric hematology/oncology in state-of-the-art hospitals in Chicago, U.S.A. The RH program is based on the collaboration of Northwestern University Feinberg Medical School (Children's Memorial hospital) and Charles University 2nd Medical Faculty (Motol Hospital). Students with a serious career interest in the field of pediatric hematology/oncology are encouraged to apply. The specific goal of the program is to provide a broad based experience in benign and malignant hematology as well as medical oncology through participating in inpatient and outpatient rounds with residents, fellows, and attending faculty. Special attention is given to developing the students' awareness of ethical issues relating to patient care.

Selected students receive a short-term (4-6 weeks) training in a superb academic environment by working as part of a multidisciplinary team responsible for the management of complex patients with a variety of malignancies, including acute leukemia and lymphoma. Students are exposed to various treatment approaches, including stem cell transplantation. During each clinical shift, the supervising physicians directly observe the students' skills and provide real-time, ongoing feedback.
